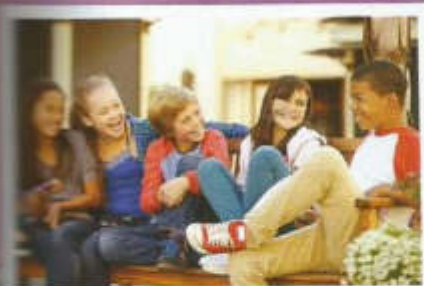
Paul, Nicole, Jeff, Cathy and Pam do lots of different things.

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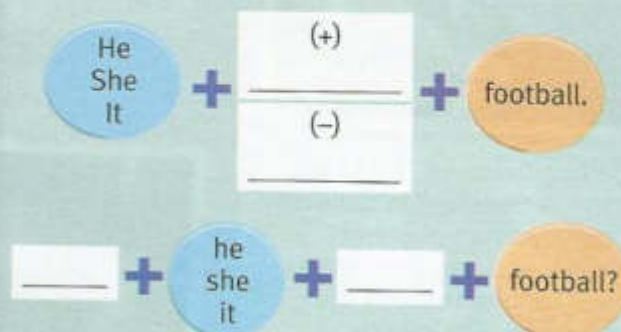
